School-based or Centrally-based Training for Lunchtime Supervisors/ Support Staff

Communicating with Children and Managing Behaviour

Trainer Shirley Rose

A two morning school - based course offering lunchtime supervisors a range of strategies to increase their effectiveness. Ways to improve communication and inclusion within the school are also explored.

(This is applicable to both primary and secondary schools).

Positive Lunchtimes: Excellent Behaviour through Active Play

A two morning school - based course to enable primary school lunchtime staff to manage behaviour and organise structured activities for pupils. Participants will undertake and practice teaching the activities.

Planning Play at Lunchtime

A one morning session which enables primary school lunchtime staff to organise playground activities.

Safeguarding Children

This one morning training is relevant to all support staff in schools. Participants are taught to recognise the signs of child abuse, and how to respond appropriately. This is applicable to both primary and secondary schools.

Healthy Eating
